## Solid Waste & Recycling Curbside Regulations & Schedule

### RECYCLING

#### CURBSIDE RECYCLING COLLECTION



#### NEW COLLECTION DAY

As of January 1, 2014, curbside commingled recycling will be collected by Suburban Disposal. The day of collection will be THURSDAY. The **EAST SIDE** will be collected on one Thursday, the **WEST SIDE** will be collected on the next Thursday and will follow an alternating schedule each week. The NJ Transit Railroad divides the borough in half.

Items acceptable for Curbside Recycling are:

#### PLASTICS NUMBERS 1 – 7

- Juice boxes
- Water bottles
- Soft drink bottles
- Yogurt cups
- Egg cartons
- Dry cleaning bags
- Styrofoam
- Meat trays
- Flexible film packaging
- Cookie trays
- Plastic bags
- Newspaper bags
- Detergent/shampoo bottles
- Hard plastic toys
- Outdoor furniture, etc.
- Aseptic packaging (ex: soup boxes milk containers)
- Carry-out containers (food and drink)

#### ALUMINUM & BI-METAL CANS

- soup, drink, food.

#### GLASS - ALL COLORS, CLEAR, GREEN, BROWN

All food containers should be rinsed and cleaned of debris prior to disposal. Please use collection containers no larger than 30 gallons.

Commingled recycling must be at the curb before 7:00am the day of collection.

### GARBAGE COLLECTION



Suburban Disposal, under a contract with the municipality, performs curbside garbage collection for both the **EAST** and **WEST** side of the borough. Please place items in the correct containers.

*(Household Batteries can go in with household garbage)*

**WEST SIDE GARBAGE COLLECTION:**  
Mondays (place at curb before 7am)

**EAST SIDE GARBAGE COLLECTION:**  
Tuesdays (place at curb before 7am)

### BULKY TRASH COLLECTION

Items that are accepted are:

- Furniture
- Carpeting
- Non-metal items
- Windows/mirrors/pane glass must be taped with an "X".

**EAST SIDE COLLECTION:**  
1st Wednesday of the Month

**WEST SIDE COLLECTION:**  
2nd Wednesday of the Month

Garbage and Bulky Trash must be placed at the curb before 7:00am

## CARDBOARD COLLECTION

The 3rd Wednesday of the month for BOTH sides of the borough. Items that are accepted are:

- Cardboard boxes/press board
- Cereal & pasta boxes
- Brown paper bags;
- Paper towel/toilet paper rolls
- Pizza boxes
- Cardboard cup holders & egg cartons



Tie into bundles or place flat in cardboard box for collection at curb.

## SCRAP METAL COLLECTION

The 4th Wednesday of the month for BOTH sides of the borough. Items acceptable for pickup include anything that is at least 75% metal.

Scrap metal items include:

- Bicycles
- Refrigerators\*
- Washers & dryers
- Cookie sheets
- Coat hangers
- Cast iron
- Radiators
- Basketball pole (no concrete or plastic base),



\*Appliances such as refrigerators, air conditioners, etc. containing “Freon or CFC’s” must be certified that the Freon and CFC’s have been removed by a certified person or vendor and that a sticker (supplied by the removal company) is attached to the appliance. This is required by law!

## MOVING?

Call 2 weeks prior to closing to schedule a pick up. Items that can be recycled will not be collected. Please bring them to the drop off site. This is a one time collection, please schedule accordingly.

All grass, leaves and brush are accepted with a resident compost permit. Permits can be purchased at Borough Hall Monday – Friday, 9:00 am to 3:30 pm. Call 201 818-4400 ext. 200 for more information. **NO LANDSCAPERS OR CONTRACTORS** are allowed.

The county offers an “Earth Machine” that turns yard waste and kitchen scraps into rich garden soil. It is a compost bin that you can order from them. The cost this year is \$53.00 and you can call for an appointment at BCUA at 201 807-5825 to pick up.

## **NEWSPAPER COLLECTION**

**Newspapers are collected curbside by the Boy Scouts.**

Collection begins at 8:00 a.m. on the days listed. Newspapers must be tied with string or twine into bundles no higher than 12 to 15 inches, weighing no more than 25 pounds. Do not put newspapers into brown paper bags. Only newspapers and their inserts will be collected. All other materials found within the newspapers will be left at the curb.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### ***How do I dispose of electronic waste items/hazardous waste items?***

Bergen County Utilities Authority has collection dates during the year at various county locations. Electronic items accepted are computer towers/monitors/key boards; televisions; microwaves; fax machines, etc.. Hazardous Waste items are listed at the BCUA website. [www.bcua.org](http://www.bcua.org). Please call 201 807-5828 for more information. **DO NOT** bring these items to the Drop Off site. The Borough does not have a collection for e-waste or hazardous waste. See back page for dates and locations.

### ***How do I receive messages/notifications from the borough?***

You will be notified about important information with the use of reverse 911, text message, and e-mail.
