ROLL CALL: A regular meeting of the Allendale Board of Health was held in the Municipal Building on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Bruce Beck, Vice President.

SECRETARY/REGISTRAR'S REPORT

HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS

-Asian Cuisine had some cleaning violations but were satisfactory otherwise.

-Clyde's self serve yogurt has opened. They have five machines, with 2 flavors each, and have vanilla and chocolate soft serve ice cream. They will be rotating the yogurt flavors and have a variety of syrups and toppings as well.

-The pool at the Whitney is almost completed and they are now are in the process of installing showers in the clubhouse. It is a rectangular pool, three feet to five feet deep, with no diving boards or slides.

-Crestwood Lake was completed. Five composite soil samples were taken from different areas in the lake and tested satisfactory. A letter was sent from Tony DeCandia to our Board president confirming the results.

-Hillside School was inspected and was satisfactory.

-Inspected Starbucks and they were satisfactory.

-A&P was reinspected because of outdated items. All items were removed from the shelves.

-Food samples were taken from the Atrium and the Allendale Nursing Home. Two of the four items tested showed a very very low amount of E Coli where none should be present.

-Inspected Mezza Luna and they were fine. Workers were preparing food with gloves and everything was in order. The owner will be attending a food manager's course since his certification is expiring and must be renewed.

-Talked to Keith Cauwenberghs regarding Crestwood Lake's final inspection. Keith advised that he would not be available and would send someone else in his place once the lake is ready for inspection.

-No new incidents at the Allendale Hotel. Meg Mantello from the Bergen County Department of Health Services visited the Allendale Hotel along with members of the Mental Health and Addiction Team. They met with Phil Anton, the hotel's manager.
