### **Minutes of the Board of Health**

**November 15, 2012**

**ROLL CALL:** A regular meeting of the Allendale Board of Health was held in the Municipal Building on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Robin Iversen, President.

#### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

The October 2012 Minutes were accepted with a motion to approve by Bruce Beck and seconded by Nadine Benoit.

#### **SECRETARY/REGISTRAR'S REPORT**

**Adult Health Clinic** – No clinic was held.

**Child Health Clinic** - No children attended.

**Vital Statistics** – 6 Deaths, 2 Marriages and 2 Births

Receipts – \$30.00 in certified copies, \$40.00 in miscellaneous, totaling \$70.00.

#### **HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS**

-Angelo's Pizza is satisfactory. A new exterminator was brought in and the roach problem abated. When Hurricane Sandy occurred, all food had to be discarded due to lack of electricity.

-Allendale Bar & Grill, Clyde's, Masa Sushi, Allendale Eats, and Louie's Place, all had food discarded. However, Allendale Eats provided food for all the volunteer workers instead of waiting for the food to spoil. Village Pizza had a plentiful supply of dry ice and remained open. Bernie's Bagels did not lose power since they had a generator.

-Asian Cuisine did not lose electric and took pictures of his freezers to document the fact that he did not lose power.

-Northern Highlands had issues with mice droppings and same was abated.

-Dog bite occurred at 24 Crescent Mews and \$2,000.00 in vet fees were incurred by the owner whose dog was attached.

-Cesspool abandonment – same was drained and filled in.

#### **OLD/NEW BUSINESS**

-**Senior Flu Clinic** - 27 adults over 65 years received flu vaccine, and 22 those under 65 years of age, totaling 49 individuals who were inoculated. Eleven doses were given to Dr. Hirschman for those employees/volunteers who were unable to attend the clinic and 40 doses went back to the County.

-Free Rabies Clinic is rescheduled for Saturday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2012

- Board of Health Budget was accepted with a motion to approve by Nadine Benoit and seconded by Christopher Martin. Same will be submitted to Mayor and Council for final approval.
