-Gentle Giant Brewing Company is selling BBQ foods that are being cooked on the premises at Rohsler's Nursery. This is a temporary event that will continue through November.

-Village Pizza – was conditional. They were re-inspected twice before posting satisfactory.

-Performed Chapter 24 at Starbucks located in the Acme Supermarket and were satisfactory.

-Inspected Northern Highlands High School, Hillside Avenue School and Brookside School and all were satisfactory.
