Minutes of the Board of Health

May 5, 2011

ROLL CALL: A regular meeting of the Allendale Board of Health was held in the Municipal Building on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 8 p.m. by Robin Iversen, President.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The April 2011 Minutes were accepted with a motion to approve by Bruce Beck and seconded by Maria Crean.

SECRETARY/REGISTRAR REPORT

Child Health Clinic – One child attended in April.

Adult Health Clinic – Four adults attended.

Vital Statistics – 1 Marriage, 0 Births, 5 Deaths

Receipts - \$56.00 collected in Marriage Licenses, \$50.00 in retail food, \$300.00 in miscellaneous, totalling \$406.00.

COMMUNICATIONS/CORRESPONDENCE

-Archer Co-op Nursery School Immunization Audit Report.

HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS

-Village Pizza & Pasta - Performed Chapter 24 and found them conditional. The food preparer used his bare hands to cut cucumbers for the salad and the temperatures were unsatisfactory. This is a serious repeat violation.

-Flirt Sushi was also conditional. Knives were unclean and had old pieces of fish on them . The handwash sink had no soap in it. Also, it is mandatory that someone on his staff takes the food manager's course to renew their food certification.

-Nosher Rye was scheduled to attend the food manager's course and cancelled. They are signed up, however, and have to reschedule. The County is being exceptionally vigilant because the law states that it is mandatory for all food establishments to attend. Our ordinance also requires that they attend the eighteen hour course.

-Crestwood Lake – waiting to hear from Keith Cauwenberghs regarding date and time for inspection prior to opening.

-According to Chapter 24, Flirt Sushi must give me a letter stating that their fish has been frozen for the required time (seven days) to kill any parasites. Certification from the wholesaler is mandatory.

-Village Pizza did have a repairman in to fix the refrigerator. Upon reinspection, all temperatures were satisfactory.

-Restaurant L pleaded not guilty to the following repeat violations, i.e. defrosting food at room temperature outside the refrigerator, dirty equipment, chef eating food with his hand in the kitchen etc.

-Allendale is considering adopting an Ordinance prohibiting ground feeding of wildlife.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS

-One child attended the Well Baby Clinic.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

-Nothing new to report.

MEETING OPENING TO THE PUBLIC

-No one came forward.
