HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS

-Dairy Queen posted satisfactory. However, it was necessary to reinspect them because there was no indirect waste disposal.

-Village Pasta and Pizza was conditional and had several violations, i.e. improper sanitizing of the cutting boards etc. Under the sanitarian's direction, the proper solution was prepared and then done correctly.

-A food complaint was received for the Allendale Bar and Grill. A complete inspection was performed and they were satisfactory. They will begin kitchen renovations and will be installing hand wash sinks in the food prep areas which will include indirect waste disposals. Plans will be submitted to the Board of Health prior to the onset of work.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS

-The Whitney's pool application was sent out accompanied by a covering letter.

-Eight vials of Rabies Vaccine has been ordered for our Free Rabies Clinic which will be held in November 2017.

-Ridgewood Water performed a pre-treatment test and a "boil water advisory" was sent out to their customers in some parts of Glen Rock, Ridgewood and Wyckoff. Allendale does not use Ridgewood Water.

-A letter was sent to the Ridgewood YMCA requesting reimbursement for inspections of their after school programs held at Hillside and Brookside schools. We await their response.
