Minutes of the Board of Health

February 6, 2014

ROLL CALL: A regular meeting of the Allendale Board of Health was held in the Municipal Building on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Bruce Beck, President.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

SECRETARY/REGISTRAR REPORT

Adult Health Clinic – No clinic was held.

Child Health Clinic - No children attended the Child Health Clinic.

-Immunization Audit Report

HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORT

-Nosher Rye has new owners and they will be signing up for the food handlers class. Performed a Chapter 24 Inspection and did find some issues which will be reinspected to make sure they are abated.

-There were two dog bites, one was an Allendale dog who bit an Allendale resident and the other an Allendale resident who was bitten by a dog from Ridgewood. Regarding the latter, all necessary information was transferred over to Ridgewood for follow-up.

-Mezza Luna II will now transition to the Allendale Steakhouse. A kitchen inspection was performed and same is up to code. However, they will be doing some renovation.

-Complaint received that there was a roach at the Allendale Beauty Salon. Visited the restaurant next door and inspected the kitchen and found nothing. I did, however, consult with the landlord, the complaintant and pest control company. They mentioned that they treat the first floor of the restaurant but do not treat the basement. In the future, however, the landlord will have his pest control company treat the basement as well. We also learned they power wash the floors and leave them wet and this can be an attraction for roaches. They were advised to dry them after powerwashing.

-The Gold Star is being awarded to the Allendale Nursing Home and the Atrium. Brookside School was also nominated to receive the Gold Star Award.

The Bergen County Gold Star Award is given for excellence in food protection. Food establishments that exceed minimum sanitation and food safety code requirements are eligible for special recognition. Their efforts are rewarded through this program.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS

-Flu Vaccine Order - The Board decided to order eight vials of Flu vaccine (80 shots) for the Senior Flu Clinic. It was decided to order less vaccine since it is readily available throughout the area.
