#### **HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS**

-Our sanitarian was notified that Northern Highlands High School was closing at 12:20 p.m. on May 12<sup>th</sup> because hot lunches could not be served. The reason was that the ansel system above the stove went off. I visited the school, inspected it and consulted with the food service director. Also consulted with the Allendale Police Department on the previous night. After reinspection they were able to open. They were asked to sanitize all areas that were previously cleaned.

-Linda Quinn and Jean Manus attended the Farmer's Market meeting held in Nicki Lisella's office. Two vendors will be selling food that can be consumed at the time of purchase. The rest of the vendors will be selling baked goods, produce, frozen meats/poultry, dry rubs and other items. The Farmer's Market will be

held outside Borough Hall and bathroom facilities will be provided in the library. Thus far, there are seventeen vendors.

-Mezza Luna will be purchasing Angelo's Allendale Pizza and are beginning renovations. Consulted with the building department and reviewed the plans.

-Dairy Queen has a new owner who also owns the Dairy Queen in Rochelle Park. He is planning to do a whole renovation in the Fall. Obtained ice cream samples and delivered them to Sani-Pure Labs for analysis.

-Nirvana is up and running and seem to be doing very well.

-Crestwood Lake and the concession stand is satisfactory.

-Masa Sushi – had repeat violations and will be reinspected.

-Received a complaint that the Allendale Hotel has bed bugs. The Police Department, Ambulance and Fire Departments have been notified. Consulted with the super and he advised that an exterminator comes monthly. However, it appears that this will be an ongoing problem because of the close quarters and the fact that rooms are not completely emptied .

-Inspected the Guardian Angel Carnival which was satisfactory.

-The Whitney had some issues with their pool. The water was cloudy and consulted with management. The problems there have now been abated.


