COMMUNICATIONS/CORRESPONDENCE

-Inspected Golden Sushi which is located in the Acme Supermarket and they were satisfactory.

-Café Mon Cher officially opened today. They will be serving coffee, tea, and ice cream. Originally they wanted to do sandwiches but changed their mind. The owner passed her Food Handler's class and is good to open. However she is waiting for approval of their Outdoor Seating Permit. The paperwork was submitted but it was never brought over to the building department for review. Same was given to them today.

-Visited Acme today because of the huge vegetable recall. Frozen vegetables and some fresh vegetables were contaminated with Listeria. When I went to Acme, everything was already removed from the shelves. A lot of the brands listed were unfamiliar to this area. I went through the whole vegetable list and it was basically the larger stores that were targeted.

-The Super Star Camp does not want to pay a yearly inspection fee and are saying they are a non-profit camp. We feel we should charge a \$200.00 inspection fee because our sanitarian's camp inspection is extremely lengthy and time consuming. The State of New Jersey has a separate code for youth camps stating that they must be inspected prior to opening.

-Reinspected Allendale Bar & Grill and they were satisfactory. The roach issue they were having has been resolved.

-Inspected Crestwood Lake and the concession stand, and both were fine. The Whitney pool was also inspected and found satisfactory. Water results for both were good.

-Toscana Pizza has new owners and they have completely remodeled the store.

-Inspected the Guardian Angel Carnival.

-We have not heard back from the Gifted Child Society and we will discuss it further if we do.
