Minutes of the Board of Health

May 5, 2016

ROLL CALL: A regular meeting of the Allendale Board of Health was held by the Municipal Building on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Bruce Beck.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The April 2016 Minutes were accepted with a motion to approve by Nadine Benoit and seconded by Christopher Martin.

SECRETARY/REGISTRAR'S REPORT

Adult Health Clinic- No clinic was held.

HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS

-The Board of Health received an inquiry about digging an irrigation well for agricultural purposes on a resident's property. This was discussed with the well drilling company and the building department. The existing well will be decommissioned because of an addition/renovation and the resident wants to relocate it to a different part of their property. A State permit is needed for digging irrigation well and it has to be approved by the DEP.

- The Board of Health received a call about bedbugs at The Atrium. Our sanitarian went over and spoke to management. This particular resident has lived there for 20 years and is 104 years old. He has 24 hour aides, and one of the aides said she got bitten on the shoulder while changing the patients linens. Bedbugs do not bite when there is activity. I did not see any bedbugs, nor did the pest control company. The Atrium has an outside staffing agency who hires their aides and this was a new team of aides who had been there for about a week. After this incident, management called the agency asking them not to send this particular woman back. I advised them to have the pest control company come in, just to check it out. They temporarily put the resident in another room while they renovate his room and put down new flooring. The regular pest control company is coming in and are sending their dedicated unit for bedbugs just as a precautionary measure. They are doing a full surveillance and treatment of the room. They also did a full body screening of the gentleman and found no bites whatsoever.

-Performed a complaint investigation for the Nirvana/Village Pizza dumpster. Also told them that their back kitchen doors cannot be kept open.

-Reinspected Acme Markets who were satisfactory.

-Inspected Sky Zone who was satisfactory.

- Café Mon Cher- consulted with new restaurant owners to discuss pre-opening requirements.

-Crestwood Lake- Scheduled a pre-opening inspection date, including a date for the Bonding and Grounding inspection.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS

-Letters were signed and sent to the Allendale Whitney for their annual fee to inspect and operate their bathing facility and also sent to the Gifted Child Society for their annual pre-operational inspection of their Youth Camp.
