Minutes of the Board of Health

April 7, 2016

ROLL CALL: A regular meeting of the Allendale Board of Health was held in the Municipal Building on the above date. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Bruce Beck.

The following members were present: Linda Morgan, Susan Toron, Christopher Martin and Bruce Beck. Absent was Nadine Benoit, Robin Iversen and Maria Crean. Also present was Lauren Meeker, our sanitarian.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The March 2016 Minutes were accepted with a motion to approve by Christopher Martin and seconded by Linda Morgan.

SECRETARY/REGISTRAR'S REPORT

Adult Health Clinic – Two residents attended.
Child Health Clinic – No children attended.
Vital Statistics – 2 Deaths, no Births, no Marriages.
Receipts - \$60.00 collected for certified copies.

COMMUNICATIONS/CORRESPONDENCE

HEALTH OFFICER/SANITARY REPORTS

-A new food establishment is going in where Clyde's was. They are calling it Café Mon Chere. They want to do ice cream, coffees and sandwiches. When I inquired as to where they will be making said sandwiches they replied "at home" and we will bring them in. I explained that that was not permitted. They plan to open sometime in May and I will be observing them very closely.

-Performed a pre-opening inspection at Dairy Queen because they were closed for renovations and our construction official was concerned since they were taking out handwash sinks, etc. However, I did an inspection and they are satisfactory.

-Reinspected Nirvana and they are doing substantially better. However, I still need to do some follow up there.

-Acme Supermarkets was conditional. They had numerous violations in their produce department. When I began the inspection I found none of the employees were wearing gloves as they were cutting up strawberries for their prepackaged fruit cups, there was no soap or paper towels at their handwashing sink, and their sanitizer was out of order. However, they do have a new manager now and he addressed all the issues. Upon reinspection, Acme is now satisfactory.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS

-The Board reviewed the "Public Recreational Bathing Ordinance/Application, together with the "Youth Camp" Inspection Application. The State of New Jersey licenses all youth camps, however, the inspection is done by the Board of Health in each town. A motion to accept was made by Christopher Martin and seconded by Linda Morgan. All were in favor.

-An order was placed for 8 vials (80 doses) of rabies vaccine for our Free Rabies Clinic which will be held on Saturday, November 5, 2016. In 2015 we vaccinated 45 dogs/cats.
