ORDINANCE 17-04 – AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, SUPPLEMENT AND REVISE THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ALLENDALE, PROPERTY MAINTENANCE, CHAPTER 199-12(J)

was introduced at the Reorganization Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allendale, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Thursday, March 2, 2017 and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council to be held in the Council Chambers, Allendale Municipal Building, 500 West Crescent Avenue, Allendale, New Jersey on Thursday, March 23, 2017 at 8:00 P.M. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

A clear and concise statement of this ordinance is to amend Chapter 199-12(J) of the Borough Code to add vehicles or parts thereof that have been inoperable for 30 days or more as set forth in the ordinance.

ORDINANCE 17-04

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, SUPPLEMENT AND REVISE
THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ALLENDALE,
PROPERTY MAINTENANCE, CHAPTER 199-12(J)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allendale, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that Chapter 199-12(J) of the Code of the Borough of Allendale, be and hereby is amended, supplemented and revised in its entirety to read as follows:

J. Vehicles or parts thereof, including boats and trailers, motorized or not, licensed or unlicensed, registered or unregistered, which vehicles or parts thereof, are or have been junked, abandoned, dismantled, have been inoperable for 30 days or more, or are in a state of visible disrepair.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that, except as modified herein, all other provisions of Chapter 199 shall remain in full force and effect as previously adopted.
