ORDINANCE NO. 16-26

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND
CHAPTER 210 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH
OF ALLENDALE ENTITLED "RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS"**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Allendale, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that Section 210-2, of the Code of the Borough of Allendale, entitled "**Fees: penalties**", is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section I.

A. The fees for the licensing of retail food establishments are hereby fixed as follows:

Establishments that only sell prepacked or unpacked non-potentially-hazardous foods, coffee or prepackaged ice cream as a supplement to the primary business	\$150.00
Food establishments not otherwise listed	\$250.00
Home delivery food trucks	\$100.00
Home delivery milk trucks	\$50.00
Ice cream stores	\$200.00
Ice cream trucks	\$100.00
Liquor stores/taverns not serving food	\$200.00
Mobile vendors	\$175.00
Nursery school	\$100.00
Nursing homes	
1 to 50 beds	\$200.00
50 to 100 beds	\$225.00
100 to 200 beds	\$275.00
200 to 300 beds	\$350.00

Restaurants, banquet facilities or industrial/institutional cafeterias, according to seating capacity:	
0 to 25 persons	\$275.00
26 to 50 persons	\$300.00

101 persons and over	\$500.00
Seasonal food operators (nonmobile)	\$200.00
Snack bars located within another business for the convenience of the patrons providing food primarily for on-the-premises consumption	\$200.00
Special event food permit	\$50.00
Supermarkets, grocery, retail food Warehouses and convenience stores	
Maximum dwelling area of 5,000 sq. feet	\$200.00
Each additional 5,000 square feet or fraction thereof	\$150.00
Maximum fee	\$600.00
Vending machines	\$25.00
Soda, snack, coffee or other non-potentially-hazardous food	\$35.00
Sandwiches, milk, ice cream or other Potentially hazardous food	\$35.00

B. Penalties. There shall be charged a penalty for license fees received after the 10th day following the expiration dates as stipulated in the §210-2. Nothing herein shall be construed to extend the time in which fees are payable.

(1) License fees of \$100 or less shall be assessed a penalty of \$50 for a period not to exceed 30 days after the license expiration date. Penalties shall be assessed at an additional \$50 for each thirty-day period, or portion thereof, after the initial penalty period.

(2) License fees of \$101 or more shall be assessed a penalty of \$100 for a period not to exceed 30 days after the license expiration date. Penalties shall be assessed at an additional \$100 for each thirty-day period, or portion thereof, after the initial penalty period.


(3) All penalty fees shall be paid inclusive with the initial license fee.


Except as modified herein, all other provisions of Chapter 210 of the Code of the Borough of Allendale shall remain in full force and effect as previously adopted.
