Re: *Street Improvements*

Dear Resident:

Roadway resurfacing has been scheduled for the streets and areas listed above. The work will include selective drainage improvements, the milling (scratching) of the roadway surface, and the placement of a new pavement surface.

Milling is expected to commence early in the month of September, and will take approximately one week, weather permitting. During milling activities, the road will remain open to **local traffic only**. The traveling public will experience some delays because of workers, equipment and/or trucks. The roadway and driveway entrances will be rough, so we ask that you use caution on these streets.

Paving is expected to commence a few days after milling is completed, and will take approximately two days, weather permitting. During paving activities, access to the roadway will not be permitted except for legitimate emergencies. The presence of construction vehicles including paving machines, asphalt delivery trucks and rollers will not allow for vehicular travel. In addition, once a new road surface is placed, traffic will not be permitted for a few hours to ensure a smooth surface and no damage to vehicles or the roadway. We ask that you make arrangements if you must use your vehicles, and plan visits and/or deliveries around the paving activities.

In addition, we ask that no vehicles be parked on the road during milling and paving operations. "No Parking" signs will be posted with specific dates to indicate when the work will take place.

If your street is scheduled for work on your regularly scheduled Garbage Pick-up Day, we ask that you have your garbage at the curb before 7:00am, so that the pickup can take place before the work begins.

Please be aware that all construction activities are weather dependent, and may be delayed by inclement conditions. The Borough will try to keep you informed if the anticipated construction schedule changes.
