For a proposed new single family residence, please submit 1 copy each of the following to the Borough of Allendale Engineering Department for review:

Plot Plan prepared by a licensed Professional Engineer or Land Surveyor (Section 196-1.A of the Code)
Signed and Sealed copy of survey, if referenced on the Plot Plan.
Proposed drainage details, including calculations prepared by a licensed Professional Engineer.
Soil log or percolation test results, certified by a licensed professional engineer.
\$500 Initial Plot Plan Escrow Deposit (balance to be returned to owner upon issuance of CO). Account
to be replenished by applicant if exhausted.
Borough of Allendale Soil Movement Permit Application (Section 225 of the Code).
Soil Movement Permit Application Fee, in accordance with Section 225-12 of the Code.
Initial Soil Movement Escrow Deposit (balance to be returned to owner upon issuance of CO) in
accordance with Section 225-12 of the Code. Account to be replenished by applicant if exhausted.
Soil Movement Performance Guaranty, in accordance with Section 225-9 of the Code. Bond shall be
returned upon issuance of the CO.
Bergen County Soil District Requirements, if applicable.
Borough of Allendale Street Opening Permit, if applicable.

Upon completion of the construction of a building or structure foundation, an <u>AS-BUILT FOUNDATION LOCATION PLAN</u> prepared by a licensed land surveyor will be required to be submitted for review and approval, in accordance with Section 196-1.C of the Code.

Upon completion of construction approved on the plot plan, prior to the issuance of a certificate of occupancy, an <u>AS-BUILT PLAN</u> of the site prepared by a licensed land surveyor will be required to be submitted for review and approval, in accordance with Section 196-1.D of the Code.
